

Task 2: Skills Test

Task Description

Students will complete a Moodle skills test in their history period on Friday the 30th of October (3A).

The skills test will take place in the technology centre. You will need to have your Moodle log in and make sure you can access the year 9 history Moodle page.

The skills test will include:

- Identification of primary and secondary sources
- Interpretation of sources
- Context of sources
- Perspective of sources
- Industrial Revolution
- Movement of People's – Transatlantic Slave Trade, Convicts & Free Settlers
- Making of a Nation

Details of Submission

The skills test will consist of 40 questions, students will have 45 minutes to complete the task.

Students are expected to line up outside the technology centre for their history period on Friday the 30th October.

You will need to have your Moodle log in and make sure you can access the year 9 History Moodle page prior to the day.

The answers you provide will save automatically, students need to press submit when they finish the test.

Teacher Feedback and Student Self-Reflection

- The task will typically be returned to students within 2 weeks of the due date.
- At this time feedback including information on how to improve will be provided through Moodle.
- Students can clarify or seek further feedback by speaker with their teacher or the assessment marker.
- Upon return of the task, students will also be expected to complete a self-reflection, which will guide them in reviewing their skills responses, to enhance marks and answers for future learning.
